

Located on the Whangaparaoa Peninsula, less than an hour's drive from Auckland's CBD, it is home to an 18-hole gem designed by the famous course architect Robert Trent Jones Jr. Despite its relatively tender years, the layout has twice played host to the New Zealand Open.

A BRIEF **HISTORY**

Gulf Harbour Country Club was only opened in 1997 but already has a history the envy of clubs many times its age.

The club was the centrepiece of a major development which was to see a new marina, apartments, townhouses, residential estates and dwellings built on the Whangaparaoa Peninsula.

Gulf Harbour is the only club in New Zealand designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr, the esteemed American golf course designer. Jones is known as "the father of environmental golf course design" and likes to say that he "listens to the land" when creating his masterful layouts.


Only a year after it burst on to the New Zealand golf scene, Gulf Harbour staged the World Cup of Golf, a major team event for professionals featuring the likes of Major champions Nick Faldo and John Daly.

The world's leading golfers shone over those four days, but arguably the most outstanding performer of all was the course. A star was born.













Gulf Harbour continued to gain admirers and in 2005 it staged the New Zealand Open. This was co-sanctioned for the first time by the European Tour, a first for a tournament in New Zealand, and this led to a doubling of the prize fund to 1.5 million New Zealand Dollars.

Spectators saw some spectacular golf and an incredible finish. Sweden's Niclas Fasth beat Briton Miles Tunnicliff in a sudden-death playoff after he made birdie on the second extra hole. Tunnicliff himself had set up the grandstand finale by sinking a six-metre birdie putt in the final hole of regulation as both players finished on 22 under par.

The tournament returned to Gulf Harbour the following year and the finish was no less dramatic, Australian Nathan Green firing a final round 65 to come through the field after starting the day in 39th.

Our very own Michael Campbell, England's Nick Dougherty and Australians Marcus Fraser, Jarrod Moseley, Wade Ormsby and Brett Rumford tied for second place. While admittedly the par was lowered by a stroke in 2006, the course got its revenge, with the winning score 17 shots worse than the previous year!

Since those early days the club has endured some up and down periods with a number of different owners including a member buy out in 2008. Today the club is once again thriving under the current Chinese owners, Long River who purchased Gulf Harbour Country Club in November 2013 and took over full management control of the club in November 2016. Since then the owners have invested heavily to return the club to its rightful status as one of the best in New Zealand including an investment of \$1.2 million in state of the art green keeping equipment and a fully refurbished gym.

THE **HOME** OF **CHAMPIONS**

Gulf Harbour is regarded as one of the leading clubs in New Zealand and we are proud several champion golfers have chosen to align themselves with our championship course.

The most famous, of course, is Lydia Ko, whose game was honed here under the watchful eye of leading coach Guy Wilson.


During their time together Lydia became the world number one amateur for three consecutive years, and rose as high as number four in the world golf rankings. She won five professional events as an amateur while under Wilson's guidance, the first when she was just 14.

Lydia played and practised here from the time she first started golf. Because of our course layout and practice facilities it enabled her to work on her game with green speeds and turf of comparable quality to those she finds around the world in tournament golf. Her coach also uses our range for teaching distance control and wedges using FlightScope because of its tournamentlike condition

Lydia has been an asset to our club and encouraged the growth of our junior memberships. She is an incredible ambassador for the game of golf and for New Zealand.

Refreshingly approachable, Lydia has always had time for the Gulf Harbour members. In 2016, Lydia sponsored a major junior tournament at Gulf Harbour, attracting the best young talent from New Zealand and overseas. A scholarship at the prestigious Hills Academy in Australia was up for grabs, a prize befitting of Lydia's status as one of the world's best leading golfers. This has since become an annual tournament and a fixture in the Gulf Harbour calendar.

We will likely see much less of Lydia in the coming years as she competes around the world. She turned professional at the end of 2013, a memorable year which saw her become the first Kiwi to win the New Zealand Women's Open and first female golfer to win the prestigious Halberg Award as the New Zealand sports person of the year. In 2015, Lydia became the youngest golfer in history to hold top spot in the world rankings at the age of just 17.

Her phenomenal success is down to her supreme talent and dedication and makes us all at Gulf Harbour very

proud. In 2017, the club will unveil a new board on the 13th hole dedicated to Ko.

Gulf Harbour has produced some pretty handy male golfers too. It is the home club for golfer Michael Hendry, who won the New Zealand PGA Championship in 2012 and in 2017, became the first Kiwi golfer to win the NZ Open since 2003.

Hendry gave up a promising cricketing career to become a golf professional in 2005 and one of his many claims to fame is that he shot a career-best 62 on his own course.

THE COURSE

Spectacular finishing holes, ocean views, rolling terrain and classic, traditional values. All combine to make Gulf Harbour Country Club one of the most exciting golfing experiences in New Zealand.

This 6,400-metre, par-72 golf course meanders through native grasses and vegetation and has a natural look and feel from start to finish.

Five sets of tees assure playability for every calibre of golfer, from beginners to professionals. Like all great courses, Gulf Harbour tantalises players with a variety of exciting holes. Several feature risk and reward opportunities, and none are tricked-up or artificial.

The fairways are generous, but well bunkered, while good putters will prosper on the fast and true-running greens.

The magnificent topography of the land gave legendary golf course architect Robert Trent Jones Jr. a wonderful natural canvas on which to work, and he certainly did not disappoint

The front nine is generally flat and has an open feeling, while the back nine wanders towards the ocean and culminates with some of the most scenic holes anywhere.

The golfing experience gradually heightens across the course of a round and the four finishing holes are sure to increase the heartbeat of every golfer.

The jewel in the crown is the 405-metre 16th, our signature hole and a classic par 4 bordering cliffs. The second shot flirts with the rocks and requires nerve as well as talent. A true risk and reward hole, for visitors it is a must-play on any trip to Auckland and whatever your score, a challenge to live long in the memory.





TOUR THE COURSE

We hope you enjoy your time with us at Gulf Harbour Country Club. Here are a few useful tips and course notes which should help you make the most of your round if you have never visited us before. Distances shown are from the Black Championship tees.

HOLE 1, 366 METRES, PAR 4

A straight away, open starting hole playing downwind in the winter. The 18th fairway on the right creates a wide double fairway producing a very comfortable driving hole. An open entry green will allow the player to bounce the ball on to the putting surface.

HOLE 2, 479 METRES, PAR 5

A very interesting par 5. The tee shot is played uphill to an elevated decked fairway. To the left of the fairway, the terrain drops sharply. From the first landing area the player can view the slightly elevated green situated in a saddle with little or no backing.

HOLE 3, 160 METRES, PAR 3

A delightful par 3 set amongst numerous mature pine trees. This hole plays slightly uphill to a green that has only sky as a backdrop. A very natural green setting and variable winds make club selection a complicated task.

HOLE 4, 387 METRES, PAR 4

This long par 4 plays much shorter than it appears as the tee shot drops some 15 metres to the fairway. The fairway itself is wide and receptive allowing the player to swing away. Protected by bunkers, the green is positioned on an elevated plateau and a shot played left or long will be in trouble.









HOLE 5, 342 METRES, PAR 4

A short par 4, but occasionally directly into the wind. The tee shot is played over a small arm of a lake to an elevated plateau. A tee shot hit to the right will leave the player with a very difficult approach. The view from the landing area to the green is magnificent, looking directly down towards the marina. The green is decked into the hillside with a sharp drop to the right side. The approach shot must be hit with precision.

HOLE 6, 474 METRES, PAR 5

A medium length par 5 that the longer hitters can reach in two. However, the green is well protected and a fairway wood will have to be perfect to find the putting surface. The drive area is decked into a rolling hillside that creates severe trouble if the golfer misses to the right. The gently rolling fairway will provide several options on the second shot. One can play well left and safe but face a downhill/sidehill lie for the approach. On the other hand, a second shot played to the right will be more difficult but the player will be rewarded with a level lie and easier approach to the small green. The green itself is well guarded with deep greenside bunkers. A par here is a good score.

HOLE 7, 306 METRES, PAR 4

This is the shortest par 4 on the course, but no less challenging. When played downwind the green is reachable from the tee, but with considerable risk. The small green, with a lake on the right, presents a difficult target, but allows the perfect tee shot to bounce on to its surface. The farther left the tee shot is played, the more difficult the approach shot becomes.

HOLE 8, 162 METRES, PAR 3

An attractive medium-length, lake-side hole, the par 3 eighth is normally played with a crosswind, which makes club selection critical. Playing to the right will find trouble. Playing left is much safer but will leave a difficult chip shot to the well-guarded green.

HOLE 9, 406 METRES, PAR 4

A long difficult finish for the outward nine, this hole varies dramatically depending upon wind direction. When playing downwind, a driver followed by a middle or short iron approach will reach the green. When playing directly into the wind this hole can prove difficult to reach in two by even the best players. The tee shot demands great accuracy to avoid the lake on the right and the hill on the left. The green is slightly elevated and well guarded with deep greenside bunkers. A par here is a good score.





HOLE 10, 366 METRES, PAR 4

A medium to long par 4 with spectacular views to the west. The hole plays along a rolling sidehill with a gentle curve to the right. A tee shot played right will leave the golfer with a difficult approach to the green which drops quickly off at the back. This hole can vary dramatically in difficulty, depending upon wind conditions and the pin location.

HOLE 11, 489 METRES, PAR 5

A short par 5, the 11th plays uphill and is well defended by mature pine trees, bunkers and topographic features. The tee shot is actually downhill into a valley fairway. From the drive zone the hole meanders uphill some 25 metres in elevation with trees creating hazards on both sides of the fairway.

HOLE 12, 309 METRES, PAR 4

A dramatic and novel short par 4 situated in a unique part of the course. This self-contained valley provides the setting for one of the most dramatic short approach shots on the course. A short iron uphill approach requires skill and good judgement under windy conditions. The green is perched atop a narrow ridge providing a spectacular vista of the surrounding ocean.

HOLE 13, 167 METRES, PAR 3

From the back tee this is amongst the most demanding par 3s in golf; a 230-metre shot to the green some 12 metres above the tee. The green is shaped into a wonderful bowl setting, but protected by a deep frontal bunker. From the forward tees this hole plays medium length from a variety of directions. Weather conditions and tee location have a great impact on its playing characteristics.

HOLE 14, 417 METRES, PAR 4

A long, open, grand par 4. A sweeping downhill tee shot to a fairway some 10 metres below allows the player to swing away. A shot pulled or hooked left will be in trouble and a shot placed too far right will result in a difficult sidehill lie. The approach shot requires a long iron or fairway wood to a green on the ridge line some 13 metres above. The player will see only the flag flying with sky for a backdrop. Judging distances will be difficult. This hole is both dramatic and difficult.

HOLE 15, 169 METRES, PAR 3

A spectacular downhill par 3 which plays directly at the ocean. This is the first of three unique ocean front holes. Native vegetation and mature pine trees give a wonderful setting that certainly makes this another of many memorable holes.







HOLE 16, 424 METRES, PAR 4

Our signature hole, this par 4 is the most dramatic and difficult hole on the course for many. A setting such as this is rarely found in the golf world and has been compared with the 8th at Pebble Beach or the 17th at Cypress Point. The tee shot plays over a ravine to a rolling fairway that naturally turns to the right. The long hitter can opt to play over the rugged ocean front terrain to considerably shorten his approach. Such a tee shot is clearly risky, as any shot less than perfect will not be found. The green rests at the point of a narrow peninsula providing 270 degrees of photographic ocean views.

HOLE 17, 593 METRES, PAR 5

The longest and perhaps the most demanding par 5 playing along and through the gently rolling ocean front topography. To the inland side of the hole is a long ridge line that not only provides a backdrop for the hole but creates a special environment separated from the rest of the golf course.

HOLE 18, 393 METRES, PAR 4

An exhilarating finish to the round, this long, downhill hole has broad views of the large lake and valley and a glimpse of the town centre. A double fairway with the 1st hole allows the tee shot to stray well right. However, such a shot can leave the golfer with a blind approach. When playing against the wind this hole provides a real challenge.



MEMBERS' GOLF

Members at Gulf Harbour enjoy a range of competitive golf throughout the season, both within the club for trophies and in interclub events such as the annual Harbour Golf Association pennants.

The pennant is the competitive highlight of the golfing year with teams competing over several weeks for the prestige of winning the flag and being able to call themselves the best club in the region.

Golf is available to Full Members every day, with certain tee-times reserved for competitions. The following gives an idea of the weekly timetable (times may be varied occasionally, depending on special events):

Monday: 8.30am to 8.50am is reserved for women's 9-hole golf and 9am to 9.40am for veterans.

Wednesday: 8.30am to 12.30pm is reserved for members' use.

Saturday: gam to 1pm is reserved for members' use.

As well as the regular weekly competitions, there are a host of Trophy Events to enjoy. These competitions are important and winning any of them is a significant achievement

Perhaps the most prestigious in each section is the respective Club Championships which feature several strokeplay rounds to decide the overall winner. There are four handicap divisions and play is "off the stick" within the respective categories.

Two more events everyone wants to win are the Match Play Championship, featuring singles matchplay played in handicap divisions and a matchplay pairs event known as the Captain's Cup.

It's not all about winning, however. There are also plenty of opportunities for social golf for those who just want to get together and enjoy the course and the company of good friends.

Each Tuesday during Daylight Savings hours we run a 9-hole Twilight Golf competition. The season starts November and will run through to March with a short break over the Christmas period. Everyone is welcome and tee off is between 4.00pm and 6.00pm.
